## Who are the Friends?

Many of us remember the gale of 1987. St Barnabas suffered substantial damage. The 14thC east window had to be taken out, repaired and put back. The roof had a large hole in it. In addition, repairs and maintenance costs were rising all the time.

The congregation was finding it harder and harder to meet these costs.

It was decided to ask for help in looking after the fabric from anyone, whether or not they were regular members of the congregation. The Friends of St Barnabas was set up to allow this to happen.

More recently the parish of St James the Less, Little Tey and that of St Barnabas, Great Tey became joint parishes.

**The Friends now help look after the fabric of both churches.**

## How we do it

We keep the administration of the Friends as simple as possible.

Current Friends give between £100 and £1,000 per year depending on their circumstances. We use gift aid to recover tax.

We meet once a year for the AGM, a pleasant social event. The accounts and the chairman's report are presented and members have the chance to ask any questions they may have.

## What we do

### Giving grants

Over the last 15 years or so, the Friends have given £65,000 to help keep the two churches in good repair, including;

### St Barnabas

#### Repairs to the bells

The church tower has 8 bells. The bells and the frame that supports them needed repairing. The tower itself is now thought to date from before the Norman Conquest, it is probably the best example of a Romanesque tower in Essex.

#### Recent repairs and redecoration of the interior of the church,

Substantial scaffolding was required before repairs to plasterwork, lighting and redecoration could happen.

### St James the Less

#### Renewing the floor

In recent years the floor of this very special 12<sup>th</sup> century mediaeval church consisted of painted concrete. Now it has been replaced with local pammments.

#### Protecting 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Century Wall Paintings

Extensive work has been done to reduce damage from rising damp to these important wall paintings.
